## 2. Purpose & Aim of This Policy

We facilitate a safe and secure environment for the participants in our holiday clubs. ASM Sports have a up-to date election register that ensure a live and current account of all the children that stay with ASM sports are always accounted for. This is then used for the coach to partake in regular head count against the names of the children signed in on the register.

In the event of a child being unaccounted for the follow steps will be taken.

• Senior duty manager will be notified immediately.







- A full headcount will be completed using the register to ensure the child is not present in another part of the venue.
- All staff will be informed and an immediate full search of the venue will happen. Whilst doing this all other children will be supervised.
- If the child is still missing, the parents will be contacted immediately and kept put to date.
- After a total of ten minutes the situation will be escalated and the authorities contacted. This is now an emergency situation.
- A continued wider search of the venue and surrounding will be carried out. Staff will stay in contact using their mobile phones.
- When the police arrive, our staff will be lead by them and we will cooperate in full
- Staff members would continue to search the venue until the child is found.
- if the child is found the at any point the search stops and the Senior Duty manager will start a full review.

After the incident, a full report will be made and Ofsted would be contacted and a written report sent by the Operations Manager informing them of the incident.
